

WHEREAS, the Board finds that said petition is in proper and legal form and in all respects in accordance with provisions of Section 19-2704A, General Statutes of Kansas, 1949, and all acts supplementary or amendatory thereto, and

WHEREAS, it has been certified by the engineering firm of Black and Veatch that the sewer of the land proposed to be incorporated in said sewer and taxing district is practical and proper for such purpose, and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the construction of a sanitary trunk sewer as prayed for in the said petition will aid the development of the land for industrial, as well as residential purposes, and

WHEREAS, the cost of such improvements will be apportioned and assessed against the lots and tracts of land contained within the boundaries of said sewer and taxing district and improvement bonds therefor may be issued and sold, all as provided by Sections 19-2704A to 19-2715 inclusive, General Statutes of Kansas, 1949, and all acts amendatory or supplemental thereto, and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the creation of said sewer and taxing district and the improvements thereof proposed are necessary and that the area is without any permanent or adequate facilities at this time which situation will soon result in a serious health hazard unless a sanitary sewer are provided, and

WHEREAS, public notice of the filing of said petition and of the time and place of hearing thereon has been given by publication of such notice for three consecutive weeks in the Lawrence Daily Journal World, a daily paper having a circulation in said county and the official county paper with proof of such publication having been filed in this proceeding and is now approved, and

WHEREAS, this is the day and hour fixed by said Board and by said publication notice for hearing on said petition, and

WHEREAS, representatives of the signers of said petition now appear urging the creation of said sewer and taxing district and the building of a sanitary trunk sewer thereon and other action incident thereto and no persons appearing in opposition to said petition.

NOW, THEREFORE, UPON MOTION DULY MADE, SECONDED AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas:

FIRST: That there be and is hereby created a sewer and taxing district within a portion of Wakarusa Township in Douglas County, Kansas, said district to be known and designated as Riverside Sewer District No. 9, the boundaries of said district are fully set out and shown by a plat filed with said petition, and said boundaries are determined and described as follows, to-wit:
