

SECOND: That there shall be built and constructed within said district and thereafter maintained a sanitary trunk sewer with sufficient capacity to carry the sanitary sewage of said district and when lines are ultimately constructed upon petition of property owners in the area who desire sewer service, all in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the engineering firm of Black and Veatch and ordered filed in the Office of the County Clerk together with the estimate of cost covering the building of such sanitary trunk sewer, including costs of right-of-way and all other costs incident to said project, that Charles D. Stough, City Attorney of Lawrence, Kansas, who has handled the preliminary legal work in connection with this project, is hereby designated as legal counsel and with authority to prepare the transcript for issuance of temporary notes and bonds covering the cost of said project, which notes and bonds shall be sold subject to the approving opinion of Robert Fizzell, Jr.

THIRD: That the cost of such sanitary sewer when built, including publication cost, legal and engineering fees and services, acquisition of right-of-way and such other expenses as may be necessarily incurred in connection with said sewer project shall be assessed as provided by law against the tract of land contained within said sewer district, all as provided by Section 19-2705 General Statutes of Kansas, 1949, and any and all acts amendatory or supplemental thereto for the payment of the costs of said sewer system; improvement bonds shall be issued and sold in the manner provided by Section 19-2705 et sequi, Sections 10-101 to 10-127, General Statutes of Kansas, 1949, and any acts amendatory or supplemental thereto and said bonds shall bear interest in an amount to be determined by this Board of County Commissioners and as limited by law.
