Said Commissioners further find that such special assessment equalization fund is authorized as a result of House Bill No. 42, which became effective and became in force from and after May 8, 1958, and at the time of its publication on said date in the official state paper. Said Commissioners further find that if, in the discretion of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, they shall deem it necessary to contract for an appraisal of all or any part of the properties within such County, and if assistants are employed pursuant to the provisions of House Bill No. 42, they shall, by resolution, specify the duties and compensation of any assistant or assistants so employed. Said Commissioners further find that if all or any part of said special assessment equalization fund is not used as provided by House Bill No. 42, then said fund shall be retransferred to the County General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the balance of the general fund of Douglas County, Kansas, for the year 1958, in the amount of \$40,857.66, be credited by the County Treasurer to a special assessment equalization fund as provided for in House Bill No. 42 in the Laws of the Special Session of Kansas, 1958.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the sole and specific intent of this Resolution is to provide moneys for the hiring of an assistant or assistants in aiding the Board of County Commissioners to appraise the properties of Douglas County, Kansas, and that if said moneys are not needed for said purpose the Board of County Commissioners will, by resolution, return the money to the general fund of Douglas County, Kansas, as provided in said House Bill No. 42.
