Resolution

WHEREAS, on this 21st day of December, 1959, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has before it an agreement with the law firm of Richard B. Stevens, John W. Brand and John W. Brand, Jr., partners, doing business as Stevens, Brand and Brand, for the purposes of hiring said law firm to collect unpaid personal property tax judgments upon its records against former residents of Douglas County, Kansas, who have since left Douglas County, Kansas, and

WHEREAS, the County Attorney of Douglas County, Kansas, has advised this Board of the propriety of said agreement, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, in said agreement, agrees to pay said partners on a contingent fee basis of 50 % of whatever amount is collected on said judgments, and

WHEREAS, said agreement recites that the county shall be put on no out-of-pocket expense in connection with said collections, and

WHEREAS, said agreement is to continue during the pleasure of the parties until the same is cancelled by either party on thirty days' written notice,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, at a regular meeting duly assembled, that the said Board of County Commissioners shall enter into a written agreement based upon the above terms and conditions and does authorize the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners to execute said agreement and the County Clerk to attest the same.
