The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

Commissioners Order #909 was approved. (Order on file in the office of the County Clerk.)

Additional bills for equipment and supplies were allowed as per the allowance record.

Motion was made by Mr. Hayden, seconded by Mr. Ousdahl, and passed unanimously that road petition by Lawrence Industrial Development for a road be adopted. Resolution follows:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have met at a regular session on the 8th day of June, 1960, the following commissioners being present: Walter Kampschroeder, Chairman, Will H. Hayden, Member and Elmer Ousdahl, Member.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners have received and considered the Petition and Bond for the location of the following described road; the center line of which is described as follows:

Beginning of the point 455.8 feet North and Thirty-three (33) feet West of the Southeast corner of Section six(6), Township Thirteen (13) South, Range Twenty (20) East, in Douglas County, Kansas, thence West 619 feet. said road to be fifty (50) feet wide with a temporary turn around at the West end and a radius of Forty (40) feet until the said road is extended West.

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners find the petition to be a legal one and that the proper Bond has been filed, and the said Board further find that the Lawrence Industrial Development Company, Inc., owner of the above land has dedicated the above land for public road use.

WHEREAS, the Board find that the location of said road prayed for is practicable and can be made without reasonable expense and that it is not necessary to view such location of said road. It is therefore ordered that the said road shall be surveyed, platted, and opened and that the County Engineer shall note such location upon the road records of his office.

IT IS FURTHER ordered that a copy of this resolution be given to the Trustee of Wakarusa Township and the same will be his authority to open said road for public travel.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, SO RESOLVED AND ORDERED this 8th day of June, 1960.
