The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

Additional bills for equipment and supplies were allowed as per the allowance record.

Road and bridge matters were discussed with the County Engineer, Casey Rice.

The Board approved the 1961 County Budget.

Motion was made by Mr. Ousdahl, seconded by Mr. Hayden, and passed unanimously, that Resolution pertaining to County Highway #589 be adopted:

RESOLUTION AND ORDER CONDEMNING LAND

IN RE: The Condemnation and Appropriation of Certain land taken for the use of the County for Road purposes, namely, the widening, altering and relocating of a portion of County Highway, No. 589, one and one-half miles West of Worden, Kansas.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have met at a regular session on this 15th day of August, 1960, the following commissioners being present: Chairman, Walter Kampschroeder, and members, Elmer W. Ousdahl and Will H. Hayden.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners now find it necessary to widen alter and relocate a portion of the County Road known as County Highway No. 589, beginning one and one-half miles West of Worden, Kansas and continuing South one mile, and that all efforts necessary to obtain the necessary additional land for widening, altering and relocating said portion of road have failed as to certain land, hereinafter described, and it is not possible to obtain said land and additional right-of-way either by donation or purchase, and that it is therefore necessary to acquire the same by condemnation and to exercise the right of eminent domain.

and Thereupon, the following resolution was offered by Elmer W. Ousdahl, Commissioner, and on Motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried. All Commissioners voting yes, was adopted.

RESOLUTION

In reference to the condemnation and appropriation of certain land in Douglas County, Kansas, for the purpose of acquiring and procuring certain land for road purposes, namely to widen, alter and relocate a portion of County Road known as County Highway No. 589, beginning one and one-half miles West of Worden, Kansas and continuing South one mile, now, therefore, be it resolved, and it is hereby ordered:

1. That said road should be widened, altered and relocated as shown by the map, plans, profile, and specifications of the County Engineer of Douglas County, Kansas, under his Project No. R-Ad-9(3)P-I, and filed with the County Clerk of said County and State.
