*Rules Regulation
for 4-H Fairgrounds
No Rodeo*

1. No rodeo livestock may be kept on the fairgrounds more than 3 days prior to the first rodeo performance.
2. All rodeo stock must be removed within 48 hours after the last performance.
3. All rodeo stock must be confined within the pens provided or in the arena at all times.
4. The above rules shall become a part of any future contract signed with any rodeo by the Douglas County Fair Board.
