RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have met at a regular session on this 1st day of October, 1960, the following Commissioners being present: Chairman, Walter Kampschroeder, Commissioner Elmer W. Ousdahl and Commissioner Will H. Hayden.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners now find it advisable to sell the County Convalescent Hospital located at 1004 W. 4th, Lawrence, Kansas, for the purpose of raising revenue for the necessary construction and equipment of the Home for the Aged, as provided by Law; The question to be submitted to the qualified electors of Douglas County, Kansas, at the next General Election to be held in Douglas County, all as provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in a regular session assembled this 1st day of October, 1960, that the above and foregoing Resolution be and it is hereby adopted pursuant to the provisions of G.S. 1959 Supp. 19-2113, and that the said question be submitted to the qualified electors of Douglas County, Kansas, on November 8, 1960, the date of the next general election in this County, as provided by law, the following proposition:

Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, be authorized to sell said county convalescent hospital located at 1004 W. 4th, Lawrence, Kansas, for the purpose of raising revenue for the construction and equipment of the County Home for the aged, all as provided by law.
