The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

Road and bridge matters were discussed with the County Engineer, Casey Rice.

The Board received a petition for the incorporation of a rural water district in the vicinity of Lawrence.

It was moved by Mr. Booth, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, and passed unanimously, that a hearing be held at 10 o'clock A.M. April 24th on the incorporation of a rural water district in the vicinity of Lawrence.

Motion was made by Mr. Booth, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, and carried unanimously, to purchase 3 blinds - 2 for the clerk of the court and 1 for the Superintendent.

Bids were opened on road projects - 15 FAS - 16 FAS - 17 FAS and 18 FAS. (Oiling roads) The bids were taken under consideration.

Motion was made by Mr. Ousdahl, seconded by Mr. Booth, and passed unanimously that Jean Murphy of Eudora be employed to furnish and install drapes at the County Home at a cost of \$907.00.

Motion was made by Mr. Booth, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, and passed unanimously, that the Courthouse be closed from 1:30 until 3:00 P.M. Monday, April 10th, for the funeral of Bernice Davis.

Kanwaka Township Board met with the Board to discuss Road petition presented by Mr. James Vestal.

Motion was made by Mr. Ousdahl, seconded by Mr. Booth, and passed unanimously that Wesley Wulfkuhle, Carl Kampschroeder and Russell Houk be appointed viewers for road as petitioned by Mrs. James Vestal. Hearing for road to be held on May 10th at 2:00 o'clock P.M.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Monday, April 10, 1961.

It was moved by Mr. Ousdahl, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder and passed unanimously, that the name of the new county rest home be designated as "ValleyView Home"
