

The following schedule of fees shall be in effect from January 1st to December 31st of each calendar year:

1. Cabins and camping rates as posted at cabins and camp sites.
  2. Fishing - annual permit \$1.00
  3. Boats - annual permit 

County Resident	1.50
Non-Resident	5.00
Annual	3.00
Daily	.50
  4. Motors - 10 horse power or less 

County Resident	15.00
Non-Resident	2.00 horse power
  5. Motors over 10 horse power
- This includes skiing permits at posted hours.

#### BOATS AND BOATING.

6. Boats shall be operated on Lone Star Lake for the purpose of fishing only, except that skiing is permitted on Wednesday and Thursday of each week between the hours of 1:00 P.M. and 7:30 P.M. and pleasure boating is permitted at other times within the area herein after set out.

The area on which skiing and pleasure boating is permitted shall be confined to an area described as follows - North boundary shall be a line 100 feet from the dam; South boundary shall be  $\frac{2}{3}$  the distance from the dam to Elk's Point; west boundary shall be 100 feet from west bank of lake; east boundary shall be  $\frac{2}{3}$  the distance across the lake from the West bank at the narrowest point. Skiing and pleasure boating area shall be plainly marked out by buoys.

No inboard motor boats shall be permitted on the lake at any time.

The pilot of any boat or vessel shall have aboard one life preserver, ring buoy, buoyant vest, or buoyant cushion of the type approved by the United States Life guard, in good and servicable condition for each person on Board

Crew of skiing boat shall be not less than one pilot and one observer.

No one under 16 years of age shall pilot a ski boat.

All skiers shall wear life preservers while skiing.

Speed limits for pleasure boating shall be not to exceed 8 miles per hr.

Speed limits for ski boats shall not apply but all other safety regulations shall apply.

Speed limits in "fishing only" water shall be trolling speed which shall not exceed 4 miles per hour.

Skiing and pleasure boating season shall be from May 30th to September 30th inclusive.
