The following Resolution to transfer funds was approved:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has met in session on this 29th day of December, 1961, the following commissioners being present: Chairman Walter Kampschroeder, Commissioner Elmer W. Ousdahl and Commissioner Harvey M. Booth.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners after being well and fully advised find that it would be to the best interests of the County to transfer \$30,000 which is an amount not in excess of 25% of money credited to the road and bridge fund to a special road, bridge or street building machinery, equipment and bridge building fund, all as provided in Section 68-141 (g) of the 1953 Supplement to the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that \$30,000.00 which is an amount not to exceed 25% of the amount of money credited to the road and bridge fund be transferred to a special road, bridge or street building machinery, equipment and bridge building fund.
