WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have met at a regular session on this 13th day of January, 1962, the following commissioners being present: Elmer Ousdahl, Chairman, Walter Kampschroeder, member and Harvey Booth, Member.

AND WHEREAS Kansas G.S. 1959 Suppl., 28-802, 28-804, 28-805, and 28-808 have authorized the Board of County Commissioners to grant additional salary increases of fifteen percent (15%) to the County Attorney, Clerk of the District Court, Probate Judge and Sheriff, respectively.

BE IT NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the following County Officers shall receive salary increases of fifteen per cent (15%) of their yearly salary to-wit: County Attorney, Clerk of the District Court, Probate Judge and Sheriff. Be it further RESOLVED that the fifteen per cent (15%) salary increase given to the Probate Judge is based only on his salary as the Probate Judge of said County as set out in G.S. of Kansas 1959 Suppl., 28-805, and is not to be interpreted as a salary increase as the County Judge of said County. Said increases are to be effective as of January 1st, 1962.
