## RESOLUTION

In reference to the condemnation and appropriation of certain land in Douglas County, Kansas, for the purpose of acquiring and pro-curing certain land for road purposes, namely to widen, alter and re-locate a portion of County Road 2-A, also known as the Lawrence and Emporia Road at the location as hereinafter more particularly set forth, it is hereby ordered:

1. That said County Road 2-A should be widened, altered and relocated as shown by the map., plans, profile and specifications of the county Engineer of Douglas County, Kansas, under his Project No. 23S-217 (2) and filed with the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, and incor-porated herein by reference as if more fully set forth herein: altered and relocated

2. That it is hereby determined by said Board that the nature of the change required and to be made in said County Road 2-A, shall comply with and conform to the said Map, profile, plans and specifications prepared therefore, by the County Engineer of Douglas County, Kansas.

3. It is hereby determined by said Board that the approximate amount and location of land to be taken for said purpose, is all situated in Douglas County, Kansas, and described as follows:
