The following Resolution was presented :

R E S O L U T I O N

Be it RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas, in regular session on the 5th day of November, 1962, in the Courthouse at Lawrence, Kansas:

1. That application be made to the State Highway Department at Topeka, Kansas, for transfer of certain roads in Section 13-14-15 in Marion Township (14) to the County Road System,
2. WHEREAS this road is around Lone Star Lake and about seven (7) miles in length,
3. And WHEREAS THIS is a County Lake and there are insufficient funds in the Park Budget to maintain roads around said Lake
4. That traffic has increased tremendously and the public is demanding better roads at said Lake.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED that the State Highway Department be requested to transfer said road to the County Road system pursuant to 68-516 G.S. of Kansas, and limited by 68-506 and related statutes.
