It was moved by Mr. Kampschroeder, seconded by Mr. Booth, and adopted, that the following Resolution in regard to paying guardians of recipient welfare patients in Douglas County, when said guardian is nota relative:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have met at a regular session on this 11th day of January, 1963, the following commissioners being present: Elmer Ousdahl, Chairman, Walter Kampschroeder, Member and Harvey Booth, Member.

And WHEREAS, said Board has studied the problem of paying guardians of recipient welfare patients in Douglas County, Kansas, when said guardian is not a relative of recipient welfare patient.

And WHEREAS, the Board finds that the guardians may be paid from State and County funds in the amount of five percent (5%) of the boarding home fee, but can not be paid for the legal action when they receive their appointments as guardians.

AND WHEREAS, said Board desires to pay all present guardians and those who become guardians in the future as above set out.

BE IT NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that all guardians now and in the future of recipient welfare patients from Douglas County, Kansas, shall receive in the amount of five percent (5%) of the boarding home fee for being said guardians.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution does not apply to guardians who are relatives of recipient welfare patients and that no fee shall be paid for setting up legal proceedings.
