It was moved by Mr. Booth, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, and passed unanimously, that the commissioners accept the sum of \$7902.52 as full settlement with the Insurance Company of the fire loss at the County residence located on the 4-H Fairgrounds.

It was moved by Mr. Booth, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, and passed unanimously, that the proposal of the Roberts Construction Company to repair the County residence at the 4-H Fairgrounds at a cost of \$7677.00, plus the sum of \$75.00 to complete the painting of the house, be accepted.

It was moved by Mr. Booth, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, and passed unanimously, that the Commissioners amend the contract with the Roberts Construction Company for the repair of the county residence at the 4-H Fairgrounds to substitute the installation of a forced air furnace; presently owned by Douglas County, in lieu of the floor and wall furnace specified in the original contract, at an added cost of \$185.00.
