BE IT NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that all of the places in Douglas County, Kansas, licensed by said county in accordance with the cereal malt beverage act, G.S. 1961 Supp. 41-2702 must close on or before 12 o'clock P.M. This resolution shall not alter the statutory requirements for bidding the sale of cereal malt beverages between the hours of 12 o'clock, midnight, and 6 o'clock A.M. or on Sunday or on the day of any national, state county or city elections, in-cluding primary election, during the hours the polls are open, within the political area in which said election is being held.
