RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have met at a regular session on this 28th day of June, 1963, the following commissioners being present: Elmer Ousdahl, Chairman, Walter Kampschroeder, Member, and Harvey Booth, Member:

and WHEREAS, we find that the intent of House Bill No. 377, Legislative Session 1961, relative to the eligibility to the County Superintendent has not been determined by a Court of Law, and since the present County Superintendent was unanimously chosen and elected by the people of Douglas County, Kansas, to administer that office for another term:

and WHEREAS, it is our belief that the school system of Douglas County, Kansas, would be best served by waiting for a Court action setting forth our duty in this matter:

and WHEREAS, the attorney General of the State of Kansas did by opinion dated June 5, 1963, rule in effect that said Superintendent of Schools is ineligible to hold that office;

BE IT NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, take no action to replace the County Superintendent of Schools, Earl Wilson, at this time.

Be it Further RESOLVED that if said County Superintendent of Schools assumes his office for another term he will be paid no salary, unless and until we are so directed by a Court of law having jurisdiction of this matter.
