The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

Motion was made by Mr. Booth, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, and carried unanimously, that the following Resolution for levy of $\frac{1}{2}$ mill for a period of ten years for the purpose of purchasing land, etc be approved:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, THE Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have met at a regular session on this 26th day of July, 1963, the following commissioners being present: Elmer Ousdahl, Chairman, Walter Kampschroeder, Member and Harvey Booth, Member.

And, WHEREAS, this Board finds that the present Courthouse building and jail facilities are inadequate and antiquated.

And, WHEREAS, this Board finds it to be in the best interest of Douglas County, Kansas, that a special fund be created to be used in acquiring a site for and the building, equipping and furnishing of a Courthouse and jail or expansion of present courthouse and jail facilities or for any one or more of such proposals.

BE IT NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED that a one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) mill levy be made to create a special fund for the above named purposes and in accordance with Kansas G.S. 1961 Supplement 19-1569, said levy to be made annually for a period not to exceed ten (10) years until sufficient funds have been created for said purpose or purposes not to exceed Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) which amount does not exceed two and one-half per cent ($2\frac{1}{2}\%$) of the tangible evaluation of Douglas County, Kansas.

Provided that this levy shall not be made if a petition in opposition of the same signed by not less than ten per cent (10%) of the qualified electors of Douglas County, Kansas, as determined by the vote for the Secretary of State of the last preceeding election is filed with the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, within thirty (30) days following the last publication of the Resolution by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas.
