Motion was made by Mr. Booth, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, and passed unanimously, that Resolution pertaining to the closing of roads #367, 272 and 51-F be adopted. RESOLUTION follows:

RESOLUTION

Whereas, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, unanimously find that it would be to the best interests of Douglas County, Kansas, to close part of Road No. 367, 272 and 51-F as provided in Section 68 - 102 of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949, and Section 68 - 102 of G.S. 1959 Supp. of Kansas, Described as follows:

Road No. 367

Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ Section Corner between Section 17 and 20, Township 14 S, Range 20 E, thence variation 9 degrees 10' East, North 45.80 chains on $\frac{1}{4}$ Section line to the old Road.

Road No. 272

Beginning at a point 4.65 chains West of the Northwest corner of the East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, Township 14S, Range 20 East, thence variation 10 degrees East. North 5.55 chains to angle stake South 87 degrees West 15.32 chains to $\frac{1}{4}$ Section line North 16.05 chains to intersection of the old Road.

Road No. 51 F

Also vacate all of 51 F in Section 17, Township 14 S, Range 20 East to $\frac{1}{4}$ corner on North line between Section 17 & 8, Township 14 S, Range 20 E.
