The following Resolution issuing No Fund warrants to Cole-Layer-Trumble Company, Reappraisal Company, was adopted:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have met at a regular session on this 6th day of December, 1963, the following commissioners being present: Elmer W. Ousdahl, Chairman Walter Kampschroeder, Member and Harvey Booth, Member.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, after being presented with a bill from Cole-Layer-Trumble Company of Dayton, Ohio, for their regular monthly payment on the appraising of real estate for Three Thousand six hundred ninety-two dollars and forty-eight cents (\$3692.48) now find it advisable to issue a warrant of Douglas County as provided for in GS 79-1607 of 1961 Supp.

The Board further finds that the special fund for the Douglas County reappraisal project now has been depleted to where there is not sufficient money to pay said aforesaid bill and said fund will not be available to pay said bill before February 1965.

The Board further finds that the Lawrence National Bank of Douglas County will hold said warrant for said County for the appraisal project with interest at two and one-half (2½) percent for the time said money is used.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, issue a warrant of said county in the amount of Three thousand six hundred ninety-two dollars and forty-eight cents (\$3692.48) payable to Cole-Layer-Trumble Company and that said warrant be payable through the Lawrence National Bank with interest at two and one-half (2½)
