AGREEMENT

By and between the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, and John Poverlein of Douglas County, Kansas:

WHEREAS, the said John Poverlein agrees to do the following at the 4-H Fairgrounds:

Construct a pole barn 36' by 50' with 7' eaves, to be the same type of construction and the same grade of material as that of the other livestock barns on said Fairgrounds. Said John Poverlein further agrees to furnish all material and labor to construct said building in a neat and workmanlike manner, subject to the approval of the County Commissioners, for the sum of \$2693.56, work to be completed by July 20, 1964. He further agrees to assume all responsibility for accident to himself and others during the construction period.
