BE IT NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS:

that all lands within Eudora Township which is located in Douglas County, Kansas, which lie outside of the limits of any incorporated city be zoned in accordance with the provisions of Kan. G.S. 1961 Supp., 19-2901 through 19-2913.

BE IT NOW FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS:

That any zoningrboard heretofore appointed shall not be abclished or affected, and futher that any zoning or other regulation heretofore adopted shall not be hereby amended or changed.
