The County Commissioners received a zoning request from Mr. Roscoe Sweeney for zoning from A to B 1, from the zoning Board to rezone the following:

Southwest corner of East Quarter Section 27-12-19, West line of of said quarter section, thence East on said line parallel with south line of quarter section 8 rods, thence North 20 rods, thence West 8 rods, thence South 20 rods.

A Motion was made by Mr. Kampschroeder and seconded by Mr. Ousdahl, and passed unanimously, to move that they deny the petition of Mr. Roscoe Sweeney, for rezoning for the reason that he already is legally entitled to operate a grocery store on a non-conforming basis, having started his place before zoning became effective.

Motion was made by Mr. Kampschroeder, seconded by Mr. Booth, and passed unanimously, that we accept the apparent low bid of Winter Chevrolet for truck unit #21 at \$4007.96, Truck Unit #25 of John Haddock Ford Truck and cab \$3020.44, Jim Clark Motors for Unit #26 at \$2,999.00, and Kuhn Truck and Tractor Company for Unit #9 for PU at \$1683.00.
