January 27, 1965

Additional bills for equipment and supplies were allowed, being within budget limitations.

County Engineer, Casey Rice, met with the Board.

A motion was made by Mr. Ousdahl and seconded by Mr. Booth and passed unanimously, to abolish any policy set July 1, 1964, pertaining to printing out of Douglas County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session this 13th day of January, 1965, that all county officials named herein deposit all public monies received by them in their official capacities in the banks as designated below, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all banks so listed below shall be the depositories in which monies shall be deposited by said officials of Douglas County, Kansas.
