

Resolution No. 100

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE CREATION OF A COUNTY SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF A COUNTY SEWER AND IMPROVEMENTS THEREIN; PROVIDING FOR A PROTEST PERIOD WITHIN TWENTY (20) DAYS OF THE THIRD AND LAST PUBLICATION OF THIS RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZING THE LEVYING OF TAXES AND THE COLLECTION OF SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS AS MAY BE DEEMED PROPER BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS UNDER AUTHORITY OF CHAPTER 183, KANSAS SESSION LAWS, 1963, AND ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO.

WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable to construct a 24-inch main trunk sewer, connecting to the existing sewer system of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, at 19th Street and extending southward along the Santa Fe tracks to 23rd Street and to construct a 10-inch main sewer from 23rd Street eastward in the right of way of 23rd Street to Haskell Avenue, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to create a main sewer district consisting of the properties which would benefit from and be assessed for the costs of such main trunk sewers; and

WHEREAS, part of such main sewer district would be located within the limits of the City of Lawrence, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Lawrence has consented to the inclusion of said part of the main sewer district within the limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, said main trunk sewers would serve an area of approximately 103 acres when lateral districts are eventually created throughout the entire main sewer district; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by Black and Veatch, Consulting Engineers for Douglas County, Kansas, that the total estimated cost for the main sewer district would be \$78,200.00, of which amount the City of Lawrence should pay all cost in excess of \$16,000.00 for that portion of the sewer constructed as 24-inch main; and the total cost of all other improvements should be paid by the property in the entire main sewer benefit district;
