The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, met in regular adjourned session, with all members of the Board being present.

A motion was made by Mr. Ousdahl and seconded by Mr. Booth and passed unanimously, to purchase a Criminal Appearance Docket, 640 page, with index, at a cost of \$119.40, from Hall Col, in Topeka, Kans.

Civil Defense Director, Howard Lindley, met with the Commissioners to discuss Defense problems.

Casey Rice, County Engineer, also met with the Board.

A motion was made by Mr. Ousdahl and seconded by Mr. Booth, and passed unanimously, to approve the recommendation pertaining to the sale of fireworks, by the Zoning Board. Following regulations are under Section 6-2 (21) and Section 8-2 (14).

Sole of Avieworks

SECTION 6-2 (21) Temporary "Fireworks Stands Only," which must be removed within 4 days from the expiration of the last legal date in which fire-works may be sold, so long as all weeds and grass are cut back within 100 feet of the fireworks stand. No shooting of fireworks is allowed within 100 feet of the fireworks stand, and off-street parking is provided for all customers. A \$10.00 permit fee will be charged each year for each fireworks stand location.

SECTION 8-2 (14) Permanent fireworks stands and temporary fireworks stands (the latter to be removed within 4 days after the expiration of the legal date on which fireworks may be sold), so long as weeds and grass are cut back 100 feet from the fireworks stand. No shooting of fireworks allowed within 100 feet of the fireworks stand and off-street parking is provided for all customers of the stand. A \$10.00 fee will be charged each year for each fireworks stand location.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Friday, May 21st.
