RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have met at a regular session on this 28th day of July 1965, the following Commissioners being present: Walter Kampschroeder, Chairman, Elmer Ousdahl, Member and Harvey Booth Member.

AND WHEREAS, this Board finds and determines upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the speed limit for the following described county road or highway, to-wit:

Beginning at the City limits line (center of the Wakarusa River Bridge on Main Street in Eudora, Kansas also County F.A.S. Route 209) thence North and East one-half (1/2) mile to the center of the Eudora Bridge across the Kansas River.

as set by K.S.A. 8-532, is greater than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist on the above described county road or highway under the jurisdiction of this Board.

BE IT NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED by this Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that a speed limit of 40 miles per hour be and the same is hereby determined and declared to be a reasonable and safe speed limit for the above described county road or highway. This speed limit shall become effective when appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected upon the county road or highway above described.
