Beginning at the West line of Stull Community (West end of bridge across a branch of Deer Creek) or 660 feet East of the N.W. corner of Sec. 31-12-18, thence East on Section line ½ mile to the East line of the Stull community or 660 feet East of the ¼ corner on the North line of Sec. 31-12-18 in Douglas County, Kansas.
