State Senator Shultz talked about the meeting on March 23rd of the Kansas Highway Commission about roads.

A motion was made by L. D. Rice that the combined boards of County Commissioners of Jefferson and Douglas Counties enter into a contract with Pinney and Turnipseed Consulting Engineer firm to make a preliminary study on a cost plus basis for a bridge across the Kansas River near Leecompton, the study to show alignment but not geology. Motion seconded by Walter Kampschroeder and was passed unanimously.
