The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, met in regular adjourned session, with all members of the Board being present.

It was moved by Mr. Booth, and seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, that we authorize the Register of Deeds, to photostat important papers for any citizen of Douglas County, for a fee of \$1.00 per copy. Motion carried.

A motion by Mr. Booth and seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, that Allen Phillips be awarded the contract for painting the interior of the Court House lobbys. Motion Carried. Contract as follows:

"I propose to furnish all labor, tools, and materials needed to do the following painting and repair work on the Court House. Remove loose paint, repair cracks in plaster and give two coats of paint to halls, entrance, and stairways. Work to start at foot of basement stairs and include first and second floors, cost \$1130.50. Wash, stain and give one coat of varnish to all doors and windows in halls, entrance, and stairways, cost \$354.00."

In order to facilitate the duties of the County Assessor, the availability of his office to the taxpayers, and to make access to the necessary vault space, for the security of important papers, it was moved by Mr. Ousdahl, that the County Assessors office be moved to the first floor of the Court House, and that space be allocated for this move in accordance with the latest proposal made by the County Clerk, thereby making much needed space available for the other offices. Motion lost for want of a second.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Wednesday, March 30th.
