RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have met at a regular session on this 18th day of July, 1966, the following commissioners being present: Elmer W. Ousdahl, Chairman; Harvey M. Booth, Member; and Walter Kampschroeder, Member;

AND WHEREAS, this Board finds that the collection, preservation, display and housing of records, documents, and other articles of historical value or interest have been declared to be in the public interest by K.S.A. 19-2647;

AND WHEREAS, this Board does now find that it should provide for the collection of records, documents and other articles of historical value or interest and establish
