The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, met in regular adjourned session, with two members of the Board being present, Mr. Elmer Ousdahl, and Mr. Walter Kampschroeder.

Additional bills were allowed, being within budget limitations.

A hearing on the Petition from the City, on Annexation, for Four Seasons was held. No one appeared to protest. The Board of County Commissioners approved the Petition, and issued the following order.

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, FINDING IT ADVISABLE TO ANNEX CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF LAWRENCE, KANSAS.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, met in regular session at 10:00 o'clock a.m., the 1st day of August, 1966, in the Commissioner's room of the Court House, Douglas County, Kansas, pursuant to notice of hearing published three consecutive weeks in the official city paper, for the purpose of hearing testimony on the annexation petition filed with the Board by the Governing Body of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, requesting annexation of territory adjacent to said City and described by metes and bounds as follows:

A tract of land in the Northeast Quarter of Section 10, Township 13, South, Range 19 East, described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the East line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 10, said point being 680 feet South of the NE corner of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ for a point of beginning: Thence West parallel to the North line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ a distance of 425.79 feet to a point of curvature; thence along a curve to the left having a radius of 530 feet for a distance of 156.33 feet; thence South 73° 06' West a distance of 92.24 feet to a point of curvature; thence along a curve to the right having a radius of 470 feet for a distance of 138.63 feet; thence West a distance of 1857.68 feet to a point on the West line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$, said point being 750 feet South of the NW corner of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence South 0° 09' West along said West line a distance of 1902.78 feet to the center of said section 10; thence South 89° 54' West along the North line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 10 to a distance of 330 feet; thence South 0° 09' West parallel to the East line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ a distance of 1146.69 feet; thence West a distance of 40 feet; thence South 0° 09' West a distance of 180.00 feet to a point on the South line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence North 89° 51' East along the South line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the South line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 10 a distance of 1701.41 feet to the SE corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 10; thence North 0° 09' East along the East line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ a distance of 1325.2 feet to the NE corner of said $\frac{1}{4}$ section; thence North 89° 54' East along the South line of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 10, a distance of 465.42 feet to a point 866.0 feet West of the SE corner of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$, thence North 0° 08' East a distance of 165 feet; thence North 89° 54' East a distance of 866.0 feet to a point on the East line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$, said point being 165 feet North of the SE corner of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence North 0° 08' East along the East line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ a distance of 1803.13 feet to the point of beginning containing 164.6 acres more or less. All in Douglas County, Kansas.
