And also the East 100 feet of the West 1537 feet of the North 750 feet of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of 10-13-19, all in Douglas County, Kansas.

After hearing all testimony from all parties interested and also examining the publication notice and proof thereof, the Board finds that no persons will be injured by said annexation and that no owner of property has protested said annexation, and the Board further finds that it is in the best interest of the City and will cause no manifest injury to the persons owning real estate in the territory sought to be added, and that it is advisable to include said territory within the corporate limits of the City of Lawrence, Kansas.

It is further ordered that this Order of the Board be spread upon the Journal of Proceedings of the Board and a certified copy thereof be recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County Kansas, and that a certified copy be delivered to the Governing Body of the City of Lawrence, Kansas.

The above Order ADOPTED on unanimous vote of the Board of Douglas County Commissioners, this 1st day of August, 1966.
