

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD P

January 13, 1967

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, met in regular adjourned session, with all members of the Board being present.

Commissioner Cancellation Order No.'s 405 and 406, were approved and signed by the Chairman. Orders are on file in the office of the County Clerk.

Additional bills were allowed, being within budget limitations.

It was moved by Mr. Glass, and seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, and passed unanimously, to ask the County Engineer, Casey Rice, to submit a report on damages claimed by Mr. Arthur Wulfkühle to his property on the south side of the County road west of Stull. Report from County Engineer to be submitted by January 23rd.

Mr. Bruce Snodgrass submitted revised plat of proposed trailer park, to be known as Ridgeview Court. It was moved by Mr. Glass, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, that the revised plat be accepted for study with approval or rejection to be set for January 16, 1967. Motion carried.

County quarterly reports were approved.

The Commissioners received a report from the County Assessor, Darwin Rogers, that there are now over 400 parcels of real estate in Lawrence and the 3-mile area adjacent to the City, that need to be appraised and assessed. It was moved by Mr. Kampschroeder, and seconded by Mr. Glass, that the County Assessor be authorized to hire two men to serve as real estate assessors and appraisers, till April 1, 1967, at a rate of not to exceed \$2.50 per hour. Motion carried.

Mrs. R. W. Lichtwardt appeared before the Board to discuss the possibility of establishing a County Wilderness Park, near the existing City Martin Park.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Monday, January 16th.

A beer license was granted to John C. Wooden, for the Tee Pee, in Grant Township.

The Commissioners received a summons on Case #24265, District Court of Douglas County, Kansas. Summons referred to County Attorney.

The Board received a report from the County Engineer, Casey Rice, that study as to conditions of LeCompton Bridge was underway and that a final report from the Douglas and Jefferson County Engineer's would be available in the very near future.

Received correspondence from Mayor of City of Lawrence, concerning a possible Railroad crossing on North Iowa Street. It was moved by Mr. Booth, seconded by Mr. Glass, that the County Engineer review possible crossing site and report to Board of Commissioners on right-of-way and crossing requirements. Motion Carried.

It was moved by Mr. Kampschroeder, and seconded by Mr. Glass, that an agreement be entered into with the State Highway Commission for the treatment of noxious weed on State Highway right-of-way within Douglas County. Agreement to be for one year, ending December 31, 1967. Charges for service to be wholesale cost of materials plus \$6.00 per hour for equipment rental and labor. This rate shall apply for any work done by Douglas County Bindweed personell for the year 1967. Motion carried.

It was moved by Mr. Kampschroeder, seconded by Mr. Glass, that the present Free Fair Board be reappointed to serve for a one year term. Motion carried.
