This schedule shall apply to all regular, full time employees and shall supersceed and concell all previous wage provisions and or wage schedules.

After sufficient service the employee shall be paid at least the minimum set forth in his wage scale bracket. The wage scale bracket covering the years of service is to compensate the more efficient and exceptional employee.
