## C O N T R A C T

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 8th day of March, 1967, by and between the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, first party, and Edgar Swank, Centropolis, Kansas, second party; the parties hereto agree that second party shall operate the water well located at the Weigh station at Baldwin Junction in Douglas County, Kansas, under the following terms and conditions:

1. Term of contract. This agreement shall be for one year from the date hereof and shall continue year to year unless terminated by either party upon the giving of written notice thirty days prior to the expiration of the year.
2. The necessary pump and pipe for operation of the well are to be furnished by first party and installed by second party.
