The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, with all members of the Board being present.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of March 17, 1967.

It was moved by Mr. Kampschroeder, seconded by Mr. Glass, that the bid of Beachner Construction Co., of St. Paul, Kansas, in the amount of \$19,069.20 for construction of a bridge on the Douglas - Franklin County line be accepted. Bridge known as Douglas County #0.00-14.55 and Franklin County #24.0-14.55. Douglas County share of contract price to be 67.2% or \$12,814.50. Motion carried.

Dr. Wempe, Charles Stough, Attorney; Jack Robinson, Black-Veatch Engineer; George Williams, City of Lawrence Public Works Director; Junius Underwood and Glenn Kappelman, Appraisers for Wakarusa Main Sewer District No. 10, met with the Board to discuss a charge of \$433.85 made against Dr. Wempe for additional work on his land in installation of sewer. After conference with the parties, it was decided that the additional charge was the obligation of Dr. Wempe and should be paid by him. It was moved by Mr. Glass, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, that the appraisers be instructed to review the land belonging to Dr. Wempe, and establish a value as to damages done to his lateral system. Further, that the attorney be instructed to prepare an agreement between Dr. Wempe and Douglas County, whereby, Dr. Wempe agrees to participate in a sewer benefit district at a later date when there is a demand for sub-districts that could include his land. Motion carried.
