

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD P

Received a report from Ray Wells, Lawrence City Manager, concerning the recommended location of a proposed Kansas River Bridge within the City of Lawrence. Report will be taken under advisement by the Board of Commissioners.

Evan Griffith, Wakarusa Township Trustee and other Board members appeared to discuss the possibility of constructing bridges on a Township road, south of Lawrence. Township Board advised to meet with the County Engineer and develop plans for the structures.

It was moved by Mr. Kampschroeder, seconded by Mr. Glass, that the minutes of the County Zoning Board of May 29, 1967, as pertains to the property described as:

All of the Southeast one quarter of 23-12-19, that is South of the existing Turnpike right-of-way, containing 87 acres more or less - commonly known as the Hallmark Card Land, be accepted and approved.

The land shall be re-zoned from Agriculture to I-1, - Light Industrial. Motion carried.

It was moved by Mr. Glass, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, that the salary of Darwin Rogers, County Assessor, be increased to \$550.00 per month, for the balance of 1967, effective June 1, 1967. Motion carried.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Monday, June 5th.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, with all members of the Board being present.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of June 2, 1967.

It was moved by Mr. Kampschroeder, seconded by Mr. Glass, that Commissioner Booth and Lawrence Leonhard be appointed to serve as the Douglas County members of the City-County Health Board for a one year term, expiring April 30, 1968. Motion carried.

Mrs. R. W. Lichtwardt appeared before the Board to discuss possible park areas, adjacent to the City Martin Park.

It was moved by Mr. Glass, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, that the County enter into an agreement with the Kansas State Highway Commission covering a certain water well at the intersection of U.S. Highways 56 and 59, at Baldwin Junction, Douglas County, Kansas. Agreement to allow Douglas County to operate and maintain said well and to repair any and all damage to State property occasioned by said operation and maintenance. Motion carried.

Received copy of letter from Forrest A. Jackson, Attorney, for Willow Springs Township, concerning opening a roadway to the property of Mr. and Mrs. Max D. Kennedy, located in Willow Springs Township. Letter referred to County Attorney.

It was moved by Mr. Glass, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, that the County Clerk be instructed to draw a warrant on the Special Building & Equipment Fund, in the amount of \$50,000.00, payable to the Douglas County State Bank, Lawrence, Kansas. Said amount to be invested by the Bank in 90 day United States Treasury bills, as provided in KSA 19-1571. Motion carried.

It was moved by Mr. Glass, seconded by Mr. Booth, that the Register of Deeds be advised that there will be no salary changes made in her office at this time. Motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Mr. Booth, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, that the Register of Deeds be authorized to purchase a new IBM model C typewriter, for a sum of \$410.00, with trade in of an old typewriter. Mr. Booth and Mr. Kampschroeder voted in favor, Mr. Glass against.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Wednesday, June 7th.
