Discussed zoning problems with the County Zoning Administrator, John Clyatt, particularly in reference to Wells Acres. It was moved by Mr. Glass, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, that the Zoning Administrator be instructed to submit to the Board of Zoning Appeals any approved plats that were in existence prior to the adoption of the County Zoning regulations, said plats to be reviewed by the Board of Zoning Appeals for any necessary changes or variations that would be needed to comply with the current Zoning regulations. Motion carried.

The following group appeared before the Board to discuss the right-of-way problems that are in existence on the proposed County Road FAS 1375. Emmett Johanning - Carl VanHoesen - Carl E. Russell - Donald Churchbaugh - John Beeghley - Harold Seele - Lloyd A. Wilson - and C.E. VanHoesen. The Chairman advised the group of the status of the tracts that have not agreed to furnish the necessary right-of-way. After much discussion the group expressed appreciation for the hearing, no further action taken.
