It was moved by Mr. Glass, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, that the Commissioners enter into an agreement with the Schendel Pest Control Company, for termite treatment of the Courthouse premises, at a sum of \$702.00. Motion carried.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session, with all members of the Board being present.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of August 25, 1967.

Received minutes of Douglas County Planning Board, meeting of August 24, 1967. Also, received letter from Don Julian, Vice-Chairman of the Board, requesting an extension of the temporary conditional permit for a 10 day period, and a meeting of the interested parties and the County Commissioners.

It was moved by Mr. Glass, seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, that the temporary conditional permit be extended until September 14, 1967, as recommended by the Douglas County Planning Board. Effective September 15, 1967, any operation of an asphalt plant on the premises leased by Concrete Materials from Mr. Fred Bremer, shall be in violation of the County Zoning regulations. Motion carried.

Met with the Lawrence City Manager and Lawrence Public Works Director, concerning the widening of 23rd Street, west from Iowa Street. City officials to study the plans and advise their recommendations.

Douglas County and Jefferson County Commissioners met with Mr. George Epps, Kansas Highway Commission, and Mr. John Frazier, of Finney & Turnipseed, in reference to the construction of the LeCompton bridge and any participation from the State Highway secondary funds. Mr. Frazier is to prepare a letter of explanation of the breakdown of all costs and submit it to the respective counties.

It was moved by Mr. Kampschroeder, seconded by Mr. Glass, that the Board authorize water skiing at Lone Star Lake on September 10th and 24th, 1967. Motion carried. The County Clerk is to advise the caretaker.

County payroll approved for the month of August.
