Resolution authorizing the issuance by Douglas County, Kansas, of renewal temporary notes in the sum of \$83,325.00 for the purpose of renewing said temporary notes heretofore issued for Sewer improvements, in sub-sewer benefit District No. 2, of Riverside Sewer District No. 8, Douglas County, Kansas.

Motion carried unanimously.

Members of The Board inspected a site near the State Highway roadside park, on U.S. #56, east of Baldwin, site could be used as a County Park, providing protection for some historical landmarks. No action taken.

Approved request for secondary road designation as submitted by the County Engineer. Requested re-location for part of F.A.S. Route 1275, north and west of Lawrence.

It was moved by Mr. Glass, that Bobby G. Steele, be hired as caretaker for Lone Star Lake, at a monthly salary of \$400.00 per month, with a house furnished. Employment to start on October 15, 1967. Mr. Steele to be furnished instructions as to his detailed duties by the Board prior to his starting work. Seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder, the motion carried.
