
NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, the Governing Body of Sub-sewer Benefit District No. 1, of Wakarusa Main Benefit District No. 10, Douglas County, Kansas, does hereby find and determine that the total costs of improvement of said Sub-sewer District is \$31,019.88; that all of the property benefited by said improvement is benefited in accordance with the valuations placed upon said property, without improvements, by the appraisers appointed by the Board, and all of the costs are hereby apportioned and assessed on the basis of said valuations as provided by law; that the amounts levied and assessed upon all lots and tracts of land within said sub-sewer district are hereinafter set forth in the schedule of Assessments set out below, to-wit:
