It was moved by Mr. Booth and seconded by Mr. Kampschroeder that the County Attorney durbe authorized to purchase a new desk from Lawrence Typewriter in the amount of \$215.00.

The County Attorney reported to the Board that the petition for the tax foreclosure sale will be filed on January 10, 1969.

The Board approved resolutions to grant licenses to sell Cereal Malt Beverage for J. C. Poindexter, Rt. 1, Baldwin, Kansas; Winston B. Harwood, Rt. #5, Lawrence, Ks. and Rita Scott, Rt. #5, Lawrence, Kansas.
