SECTION II

The said Lawrence-Douglas County Health Board shall be composed of ten (10) members to be appointed as follows:

1. Five (5) designated to be members of Public Health Committee and five (5) to be members of the Mental Health Committee.
2. For each of the two committees two (2) members shall be appointed by the County Commission, two (2) by the City Commission, and one (1) by joint action of the two governing bodies.
3. For the initial appointments to each of the two committees one member appointed by each governing body shall have a term of office of three (3) years and the other shall have a term of two (2) years. The member appointed by joint action shall have a term of office of one (1) year. As
