AND WHEREAS, this Board finds that there is such real estate having an aggregate of assessed valuation of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) or more;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by this Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the County Attorney of Douglas County, Kansas, shall institute an action in the District Court of Douglas County, Kansas, in the name of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, against the owners or supposed owners of such real estate and all persons having or claiming to have any interest therein or thereto to enforce the lien of Douglas County, Kansas, for unredeemed real estate bid in by the county by a judicial foreclosure and sale of said real estateby Douglas County, Kansas.
