PUBLIC HEALTH The Board received the minutes of the Public Health Committee of the Lawrence-Douglas County Board of Health of April 14, 1969.

PRINTING CONTRACT The Board executed a contract between Melvin E. Copp doing business as Copp's Decorating Service and Douglas County for the painting of the exterior surfaces of the Court House for the total consideration of \$2,968.00.

DEED REVISION The Board executed a revised deed to the State Highway Commission directing an original deed dated September 22, 1938 and recorded in Douglas County Deed Record Book #140, Page 32, under the date of January 12, 1939. Deed covering land presently held by State Highway Commission for a park adjacent to the County owned Black Jack Park on U.S. Highway 56 east of Baldwin, Kansas.
