Dear Mr. Sandberg:

Your letter of May 14, 1969 concerning the crossing of FAS Rte 209 at Eudora, Kansas, was referred to the County for their concurrence. We have correspondence now from the County agreeing to the up-grading of the protection for this crossing.

Our records on highway traffic indicate a volume in the neighborhood of 600 vehicles per day. With this traffic, our future improvement of the road would call for 24' pavement with 6' shoulders. If the signals are set the usual 4' from the shoulder line, they would then be 22' from the center of the road. With two tracks at this crossing, it will be necessary that we provide gate arms in addition to the flashing lights.

We are enclosing herewith copies of a proposed agreement covering the above work. When they have been executed by the Santa Fe, will you please return them to this office, together with a copy of the wiring diagram and estimates.
