The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board being present.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of June 20, 1969.

Salary scale for summer help: It was moved by Mr. Heck that the motion of March 28, 1969 referring to salary for incidental work at Lone Star Lake and other County facilities be rescinded and the following shall apply. A salary scale shall be re-established at the rate of \$330.00 per month or \$2.00 per hour for incidental help at Lone Star Lake and other County facilities. Motion seconded by Mr. Ice and carried unanimously.

It was moved by Mr. Heck and seconded by Mr. Ice that Fred Purvis be authorized to hire the following men at the rate of \$2.00 per hour. Fred Purvis, Jr., Mike Purvis, and Harlon Wilson. Motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Mr. Heck and seconded by Mr. Ice that John Purvis and Mark Roberts be hired at the rate of \$330.00 per month for work at Lone Star Lake. Employment effective June 2, 1969. Motion carried unanimously.

County Assessor: purchase 3 desks: It was moved by Mr. Heck and seconded by Mr. Ice that the office of the County Assessor be authorized to purchase 3 desks at the following prices. Two desks at the rate of \$189.00 each and one secretarial desk at the rate of \$226.40. Motion carried unanimously.

The Board received a copy of the minutes of the first meeting of the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission held June 18, 1969.

loss of bridge in Willow Springs Township: The Board received a report from the County Engineer on a bridge on a township Road in Willow Springs Township. The bridge was found to be in poor condition and should be replaced.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 25th day of June, 1969, by and between Douglas County, Kansas, and the City of Lawrence, Kansas.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners on January 3, 1968, acting pursuant to K.S.A. 1967 Supp. 19-261, passed the resolution in which Douglas County agreed to pay the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) per month for the period of January 1, 1969, to December 31, 1969, for the providing of ambulance service within the County of Douglas, and

WHEREAS, the City of Lawrence has made a satisfactory contract for such ambulance services.

Douglas County does, therefore, by the Board of County Commissioners, agree to pay to the City of Lawrence two hundred dollars (\$200.00) each month by warrant payable to City of Lawrence and Larry Marcum d/b/a Citizens Ambulance Service, beginning June 25, 1969, for services from June 25, 1969, through December 31, 1969, or until such contract be otherwise terminated.
