It was moved by Mr. Ice and seconded by Mr. Heck that permission be granted to rent the property until July 1, 1970.

The Board received a letter from C. E. Stadler, 143 East 23rd. Street pertaining to their taxes. Letter was referred to the County Assessor for information and details to be submitted to the Board for their consideration.

It was moved by Mr. Heck and seconded by Mr. Ice that in furtherance of Section 24-2 of the County Zoning Regulations this Board advise the Chairman of the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission that we request that Board to study the existing County Zoning Regulations pertaining to Mobile Home Parks and refer their recommendations to this Board for consideration. Further, that the County Zoning Administrator be instructed to have notice of the public hearing on the county mobile home regulations published in accordance with Section 24-3.

It was moved by Mr. Heck and seconded by Mr. Ice that the Board approve the Township Annual Reports as submitted by the township treasurers. Motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Mr. Heck and seconded by Mr. Ice that the Board allow Lawanda Hartpence, employee of the Probate Court, a six months increment bringing her salary as of March 1, 1970, to \$315.00 per month. Motion carried unanimously.

Kenneth Thompson appeared before the Board to discuss proposed uniform numbering systems for identification of land parcels throughout the County. Mr. Thompson was advised to discuss his proposal with the various County Officers who might be affected by any change in procedure, and to report back to the Board.

*policy concerning
burning of Prairie
Meadow*

Mr. Russell Hays appeared before the Board to discuss the burning of the prairie meadow in the County Park east of Baldwin. Mr. Hays was authorized to proceed with the burning under his supervision around March 1, 1970, and further authorized to contact Raymond Day of Route 1, Wellsville, Kansas, to take care of the necessary mowing during the summer of 1970. The understanding is that the meadow will be mowed not later than August 1, 1970, and the remuneration for the Hay to the County will be on the same basis as he presently is paying Mr. Hays.

The Board received a financial statement from Valleyview Rest Home for a period from 1-01-69 to 12-31-69.

The Board received a letter from Bagby & Hoover Ins., concerning additional insurance covering the properties on New Hampshire and Rhode Island Streets during their removal or demolition. Letter was referred to the County Attorney for an opinion concerning the necessity of such additional coverage.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on February 25, 1970.
